



# Permanency Resource Centers

Monroe, Schuyler, Steuben, and Wayne Counties

Catholic Charities Family and Community Services (CCFCS) provides supportive services to adoptive, legal guardianship and KinGAP families. These services are designed to help support youth permanency in the family home by offering parents and caregivers needed resources, advocacy and caring peer connections.

Participating families will be connected to a program Case Manager who will provide support services related to:

- Educational Needs
- Parenting Support/Advocacy
- Behavioral Issues
- Monthly Support Groups and Family-Focused Social/Recreational Programs
- Parent Education Groups, Trauma-Informed Trainings, and Family-Oriented Workshops

The Program's Case Managers will also assist families with referrals to other community resources as needed.
